

















# Top 6 winter getaway destinations

Winter getaway destination: Aspen In the mood for: A luxe ski weekend

What to pack: Look fashionable on the slopes with an all-in-one ski suit and Chanel ski goggles when on the slopes; plus lots of knits, cashmere and fur wraps (both real and faux) for après-ski lounging. Where to stay: The St. Regis Aspen Resort or The Little Nell, both renowned in Colorado Ski Country. And if skiing isn't your thing, you can totally indulge in soothing, winter-escape spa treatments totally worthy of the majestic setting you're immersed in.

## WINTER GETAWAY: The top luxury chalets around the world

Winter getaway destination: Québec City

In the mood for: A romantic winter escape

What to pack: Layers are your friends here. Think cozy sweaters, knit scarves and knee-high boots for traversing the cobblestone streets of this heritage city.

Where to stay: The Auberge Saint-Antoine, a quaint retreat from the snowy outdoors situated in the city's Old Port neighbourhood, also a UNESCO World Heritage site. Or you could plan your stay at the world-famous Ice Hotel, if you're brave enough.

#### Winter getaway destination: Salzburg, Austria


In the mood for: A storybook European retreat

What to pack: An oversized coat for strolling the winter markets around the Cathedral of Salzburg, and a bathing suit, for taking a dip in the warm-water pool floating in Lake Wolfgang.

Where to stay: The Hotel Wolf-Dietrich, surrounded by the rolling hills and mountains that provided the mountainous backdrop to 1965 film version of The Sound of Music. Or the castle Hotel Schloss Fuschl Resort and Spa, a former hunting lodge for the Archbishop of Salzburg, nestled on the Lake Fuschl (and an outdoor hot tub with a view of Alps).


