

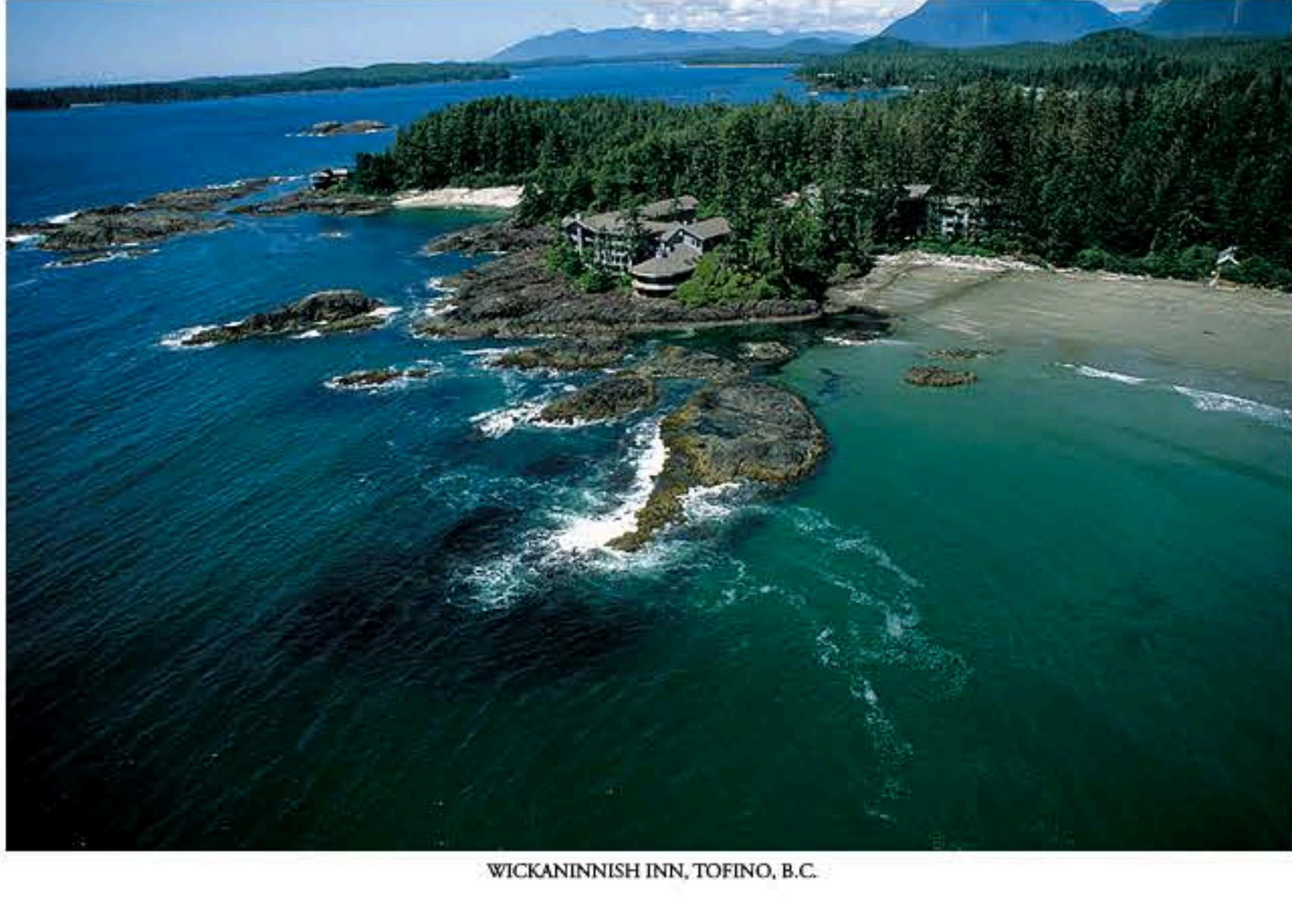
The 10 Most Romantic Hotels in Canada

1) [Wickaninnish Inn](#), Tofino, B.C.

Remote on its own untamed inlet, the Wickaninnish Inn boasts 75 oceanview rooms, including the Canopy Suite, which boasts floor-to-ceiling windows, a heavenly four-post bed, a roaring fireplace, a wet bar and gourmet room service. Savour a hot stone massage for two at the Relais & Chateaux Ancient Cedars Spa, then cuddle with a glass of vino while watching the sun set on Shell Beach.

2) [Shangri-La Hotel](#), Toronto

This five-star boutique hotel is high on the sexy factor, and you'll never have to set foot outside. Start your romantic escape off right with a night at the Owner's Suite, which features distinctive Asian furnishings, dramatic wood panelling and a soaker tub for two. Relax by day at the hotel's onsite Miraj Hammam Spa with its stunning glass-roof pool, then head to the Lobby Lounge for handcrafted classic cocktails and a live jazz set.

3) [Fogo Island Inn](#), Joe Batt's Arm, Newfoundland & Labrador

Only a few years old, the Fogo Island Inn encourages guests to slow down and get creative in the natural world. Try an art workshop, hike the rugged coast or set out in a traditional punt (a small, flat-bottomed boat). All 29 contemporary suites boast floor-to-ceiling views of the North Atlantic, where a many an iceberg has peacefully floated by. Rent the Flat Earth Corner Suite and get a cozy wooden stove. Islanders say the region has *seven* distinct seasons (fog, rain and ice get their own), making the inn a magical place to experience Mother Nature.

4) [The Ritz-Carlton Montréal](#)

With a history of amour than spans over 100 years, the Ritz-Carlton Montréal has hosted famous beloveds such as Elizabeth Taylor and Richard Burton, who were married onsite. 5) [Langdon Hall Country House Hotel & Spa](#), Cambridge, Ont.

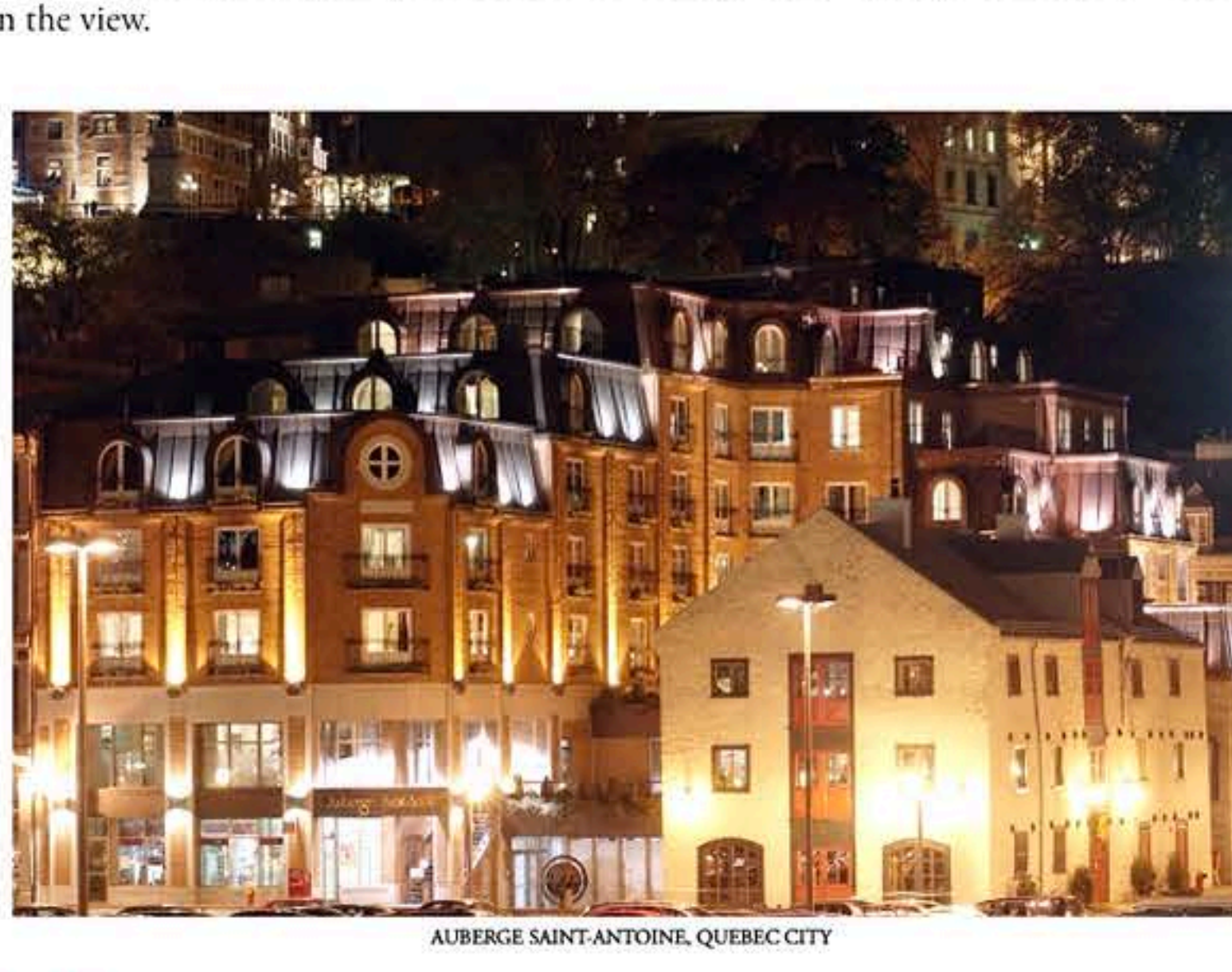

6) [Auberge Saint-Antoine](#), Quebec City

This boutique hotel is located on a private cobblestoned street in the heart of Quebec City's Old Port and a touch away from the Saint Lawrence River. The well-preserved 17th-century architecture is on display in the hotel's Four Diamond restaurant, Panache, which features heritage stone walls, wood beams and a fireplace. 7) [Sooke Harbour House](#), Sooke, B.C.

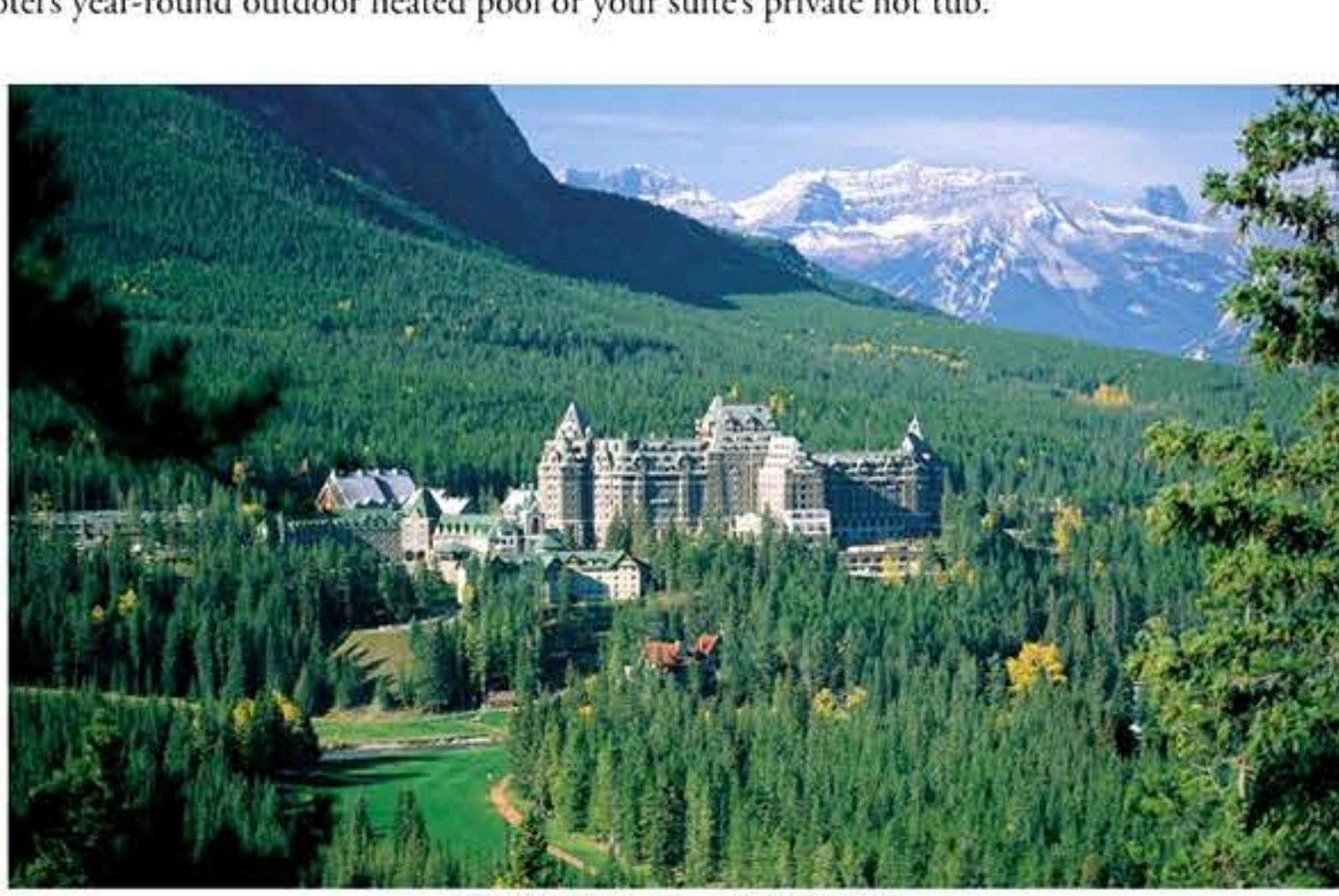

9) [Drake Devonshire Inn](#), Prince Edward County, Ont.

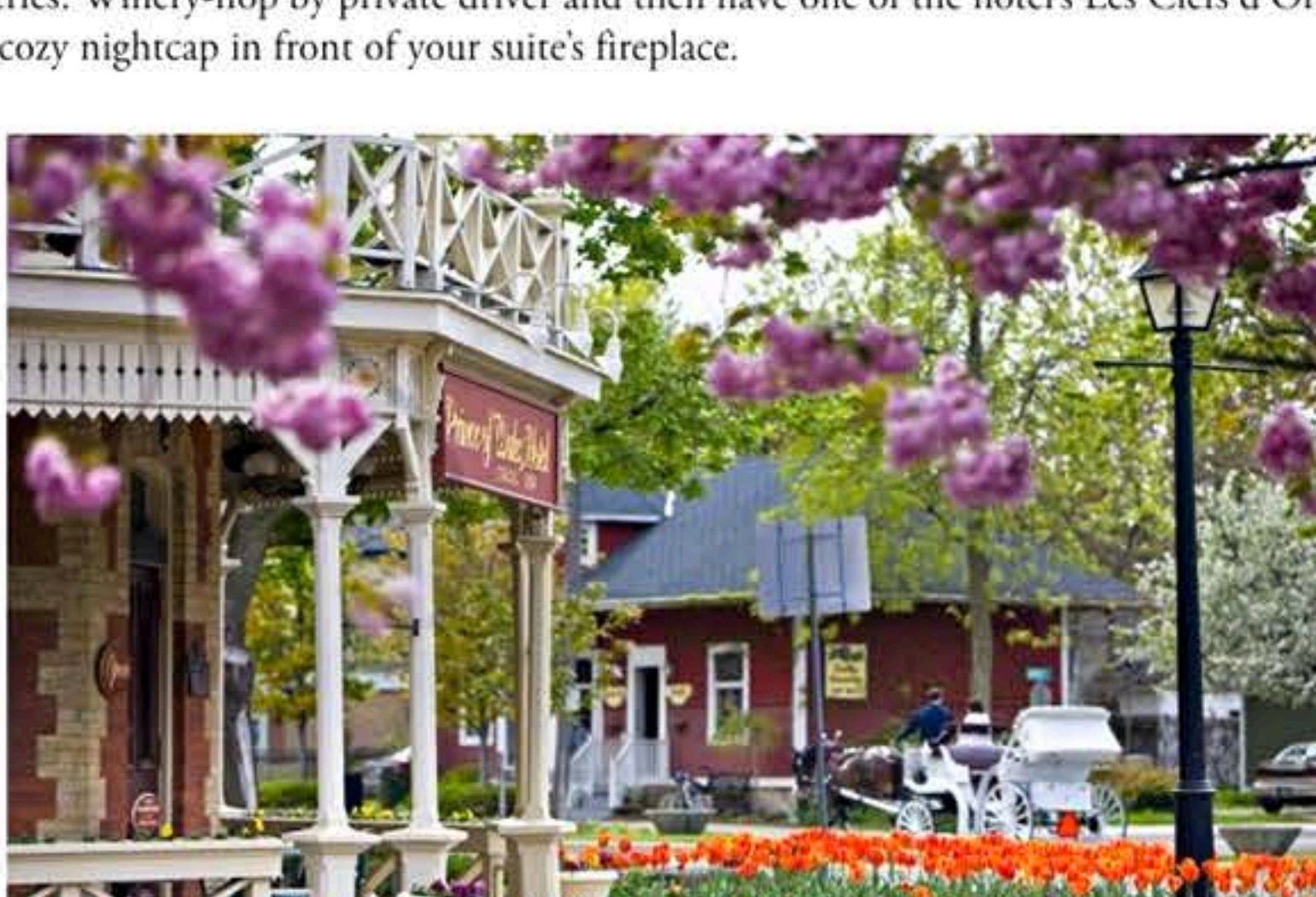

Spice things up with a Drake Pleasure Menu that can be ordered up promptly—and discreetly (bondage tape, Astroglide and vibrators are available). Savour a meal in their farm- and lake-to-table dining room, then relax by the outdoor fire pit with a bottle from a local winery.

This intimate hotel in the heart of Niagara-on-the-Lake is the perfect place for wine lovers to toast their union. With 110 individually decorated rooms, most including a gas fireplace, you'll be hard-pressed to leave—but mere steps from your suite you'll find artisan boutiques, the world-renowned Shaw Festival Theatre and dozens of award-winning wineries. Winery-hop by private driver and then have one of the hotel's Les Clefs d'Or concierge members arrange for a cozy nightcap in front of your suite's fireplace.
