CANADA POST

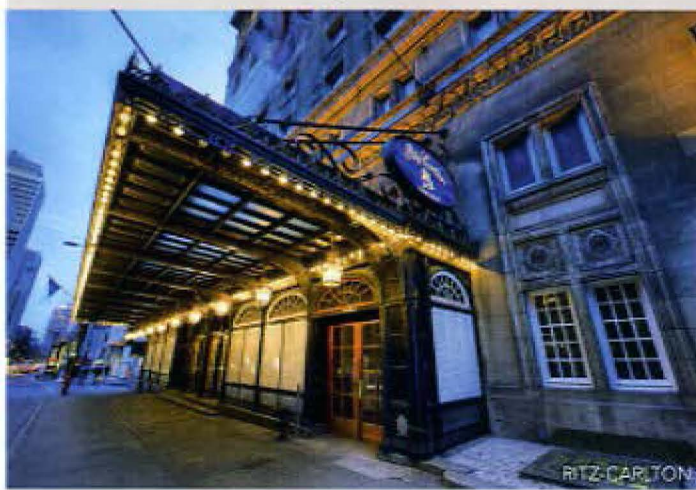
Take your favourite family photos and holiday snaps and turn them into postage stamps. Picture Postcard from Canada Post lets you create personalized stamps and postcards online or through your mobile device (BlackBerry, Apple and Android). Picture Postcard stamps are real stamps, each valued at the current domestic rate and can be used to mail a standard-size envelope weighing up to 30 grams anywhere in Canada. A keepsake sheet of 20 domestic stamps plus one bonus stamp and a larger souvenir image of your stamp costs \$27.95. Forty domestic stamps on a sheet cost \$44.75, with other quantities and prices available. Ordered stamps will be received by regular mail. canadapost.ca



AIR TRANSAT

To celebrate its 25th anniversary, Air Transat is investing millions of dollars to enhance its in-flight experience. Three of its Airbus A330s featuring a new, fully-redesigned cabin interior are already flying. Travellers in both Club (12 seats) and Economy (333 seats) classes will enjoy more comforts including roomier, ergonomically-designed leather seats with state-of-the-art touchscreen-based personal entertainment systems. The lavatories have also been entirely redesigned, as have cabin layout features including a new mood lighting system. Cabin interior refurbishments for the remainder of the Airbus A330 fleet will be completed gradually over a two-year period at a cost of \$4 million per aircraft. An added green bonus is that all of the A330s in the fleet will be lighter (by two tonnes) once the cabin redesigns are complete, which will mean substantial fuel and cost savings. The environmentally-aware airline was rated the world's greenest airline in the long-haul category by the Atmosfair Airline Index for 2011. transat.com

Following an extensive \$200-million restoration, the Ritz-Carlton Montréal has reopened.
